

Associate Pastor of Worship Position Description

Job Qualifications and Proposal

- 1. Anyone who is called to serve as an Associate Pastor at Mission Covenant Church (MCC) must be a whole-hearted Christian whose life is being conformed to the likeness of Christ and shows evidence of being called to Ministry.
- 2. Anyone who is called to serve as an Associate Pastor at MCC must be in agreement with the Statement of Faith of The Evangelical Covenant Church.
- 3. Anyone who is called to serve as an Associate Pastor at MCC must be in agreement with the Philosophy of Ministry of our Lead Pastor.
- 4. Anyone who is called to serve as an Associate Pastor at MCC must also agree with MCC's Philosophy of Ministry.
- 5. A long-term commitment to Mission Covenant Church's ministry is desirable.
- 6. Knowledge of computer systems including, CCLI SongSelect, ProPresenter, Apple Mac Environment, Microsoft Office Suite and Google Office Suite is desirable.
- 7. A Bachelor's Degree or higher in ministry, music, or related field is preferred.
- 8. Previous experience in leading worship is desired.

- Promote congregational worship
- Plan and schedule worship/song services
- Recruit and schedule Worship Team members
- Recruit and schedule special music
- Lead worship/song services
- Attend approved seminars/training relating to worship
- Assist in leading special services

- Assist the Diaconate with local service projects
- Visit mission fields supported by MCC whenever possible
- Lead any participants of MCC at URBANA Missions Conferences

Audio/Visual Ministry

- Supervise the A/V Technical Support staff person
- Oversee the A/V budget alongside our A/V Technical Support staff person
- Assist in Audio/Visual Ministry as needed

- Attend weekly pastoral staff meetings
- Attend Elders' meetings
- Perform visitations as needed
- Teach Confirmation
- Teach Mission 201
- Any other items deemed necessary
